

ANSWER

The given process chart is describing the procedure how the waste paper is recycled to make it reusable. Overall, this process includes six distinct stages from the collection of used paper to the production of usable paper.

The first stage of recycling of paper is to collect the paper from the public paper banks or businesses. In the next step, there is sorting of this paper by hand to grade the paper and unsuitable paper is removed from the collected used paper. After grading, the same graded paper is transported to a paper mill for further processing.

The cleaning stage includes cleaning, pulping and removing in which paper is firstly cleaned, pulped and then impurities like Saples are taken. Following this, all kind of glues and extra ink are removed in the de-inking stage from the paper. At the final stage of the procedure of paper remaking, the paper is sent to paper making machine to make it usable.
