

## **ANSWERS**

- 1) Yes :- it is clearly written that wilderness requires less or no investment so with this low cost attraction is obvious.
- 2) Yes:- it is given that these areas are fragile in terms of ecology and culture and the next line tells that three most significant environment in these respects (means ecology and culture) are deserts, mountains and Arctic.
- 3) No:- it is said in the passage that human activities, including tourism, are limited to quite clearly defined parts of the year which is contradictory to the question which is saying that it is operated throughout the year.
- 4) Yes:- the passage tells that in some hill regions, this (means the tourism) has lead to a serious decline (means fall) in farm output (means farm's production) and change in its local diet which is giving the same meaning to the question.
